

## 3D TV

### HOW TO CLEAN:

- You can clean your 3D TV the same way you would clean a 2D LED or LCD TV. Use a slightly damp microfiber cloth to clean the screen, then immediately dry it. Do not use any chemicals or household cleaning products on the screen.
- You can clean 3D glasses with a microfiber cloth (similar to one you would use to clean regular glasses). Remember that there are electrical parts to your 3D glasses, so make sure you do not get them wet.

### BENEFITS TO CONNECTIVITY:

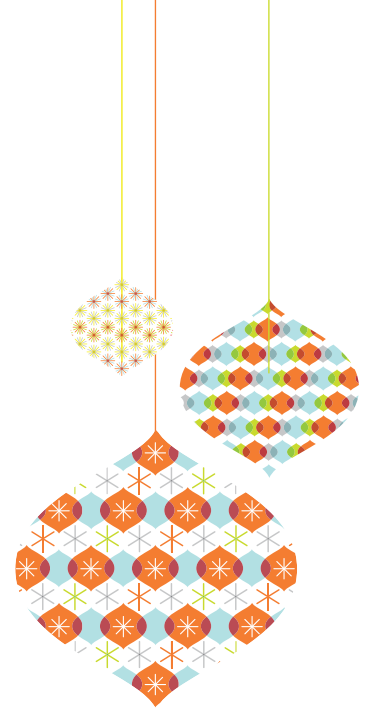
- With an Internet connection, you can stream movies, videos and music using programs such as Netflix, Blockbuster On Demand, Pandora and YouTube. You can also fully access specific widgets that may be on your TV, such as Facebook or Twitter.
- You will be able to get software updates that will make sure your 3D TV is running smoothly with the latest and greatest features.

### ADDITIONAL TIPS:

- You will still be able to watch 2D TV on your 3D TV. The 3D capability can be turned on or off.
- You should be able to use most of your television components (e.g. Blu-ray player, DVD player, gaming console) on the 3D TV, but it will not be 3D. For example, if you would like to watch 3D Blu-ray movies, you will need a 3D Blu-ray player. The exception to this is the PlayStation 3. Earlier this year, PlayStation 3 performed firmware updates, so your existing console will support 3D TV and 3D Blu-ray.

### WHAT ELSE YOU NEED:

- Some 3D TVs will come with two pairs of 3D glasses and some will not. It is important to know today's 3D glasses are brand and technology specific.
- New 3D cables and receivers may also need to be purchased, as items like old HDMI cables may not have the bandwidth to support 3D. HDMI 1.4 cables are the only ones capable of carrying 3D video.
