HOW TO CLEAN:

- You can rid the eReader screen of unwanted fingerprints by using a microfiber cloth to wipe and clean the display.
- It's important to avoid wiping the eReader with anything abrasive. If you accidentally get your screen wet, wipe it lightly with a slightly damp microfiber cloth.

BENEFITS TO CONNECTIVITY:

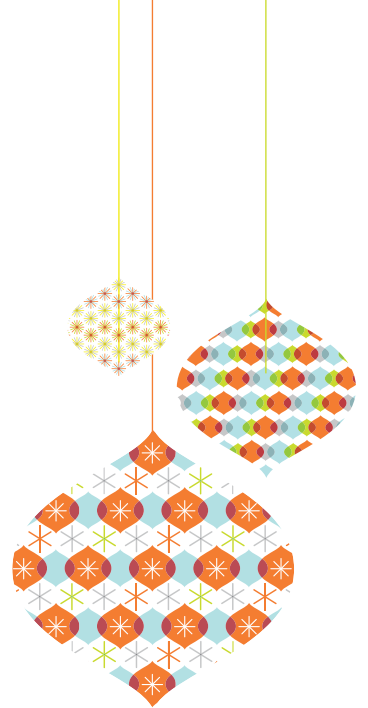
- The majority of eReaders available today have wireless capabilities. Depending on your personal eReader, this wireless function will allow you to download eBooks from multiple websites including Amazon.com, barnesandnoble.com, apple.com and ebooks.com, on the go or from the comfort of your own home.

ADDITIONAL TIPS:

- Some eBook stores, such as Amazon and Barnes & Noble, have iPhone, Android and PC apps available that will sync eBook purchases so you can read a few pages of your eBook on your smartphone when your eReader isn't available.
- There is also library of free eBooks consisting of out of copyright books such as classics by Mark Twain, Charles Dickens, and William Shakespeare, as well as daily or even hourly specials from some of the online stores.
- Some eReaders come with 3G capability which allows wireless access over cell phone networks without the need to connect to WiFi, which enables you to download books or updated newspapers and magazines while on the go. The 3G access does not require purchasing a data plan.

WHAT ELSE YOU NEED:
