BENEFITS TO CONNECTIVITY:

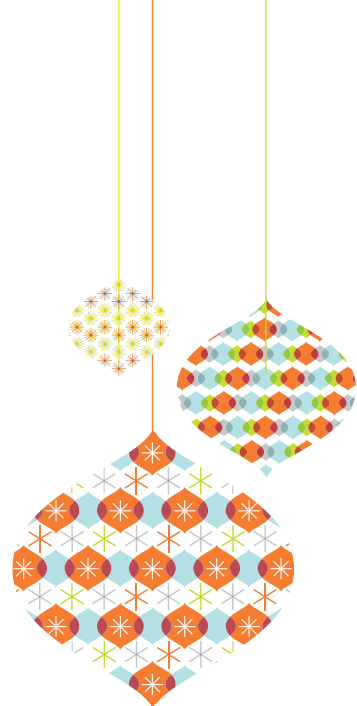
